- Building & Grounds: The boiler replacement process is underway, and a timeline has been developed. The Board will receive another briefing prior to the release of Request for Proposal's. As discussed last month, the new furniture has been ordered and should arrive within two weeks.
- Personnel: Our newly hired maintenance person will not be kept on past their probationary period. We will post for this position again. We also hired a secondary special education teacher to focus on 'push-in,' services (the teacher goes into the regular ed classroom to support a student receiving special education services). Almost all our secondary students are in general ed classrooms and have services by this teacher. This also freed up our other special education teacher to have more time with her elementary students. By all accounts this is going very well.

Public Comments

Laura Cavendish inquired about the tree dedication for Nancy Peterson. Superintendent Wetherbee explained that we have dedicated a tree for her and will be installing the plaque when the weather improves. Laura also noted that her daughter, Arya, loves having Mr. Jeffrey (the new special education teacher) in class.
